

International Education Scholarship Information 2011

The **Government of Western Australia**, through the Department of Education (DOE), is offering a number of prestigious scholarships for international students to undertake the Western Australian Universities' Foundation Program (WAUFP) or Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) program at Tuart College in Perth, Western Australia (WA). Applicants from all countries will be eligible for consideration.

Scholarship winners are selected on the basis of academic results and a reference from the school. Where academic results do not allow for differentiation between applicants, resumes or curriculum vitae will be considered. Year 11 students at Tuart College may apply for an award on the basis of their Year 11 results.

Scholarships apply to Year 12 level courses; the WA Universities' Foundation Program and the WA Certificate of Education Program. **The closing date for all scholarship applications will be 29 October 2010. Notifications will be issued by the 12th November 2010.**

Full Scholarships

Three (3) Full Scholarships covering the course fee will be awarded.

To be awarded a full scholarship requires a student to have achieved outstanding academic results. This would normally require the student to have achieved the highest possible grade in at least **six (6)** subjects.

Students will be required to complete an International Student Application Form, an International Scholarship Application Form and pay A\$200 non-refundable fee. The A\$200 fee will be deducted from the student's tuition fees in the event of not gaining a scholarship but enrolling at the College.

Additional documentation required:

1. Reference from the school principal.
2. Actual or mock/forecast/preliminary results for major examinations equivalent to Year 11 in Western Australia.
3. Two (2) most recent school reports.
4. Curriculum Vitae or resume.

Partial \$5,000 Scholarships

Ten (10) scholarships to the value of A\$5,000 are being offered.

This award would normally require the student to have achieved the highest possible grade in at least **five (5)** subjects.

These scholarships may be offered to students at anytime, including during marketing visits. Such students must pay a non-refundable deposit of A\$500 within **two (2)** weeks of the offer or forfeit the scholarship.

Students accepting one of these scholarships will also be considered for a full scholarship and the A\$500 deposit will be transferred to the refundable Bond.

There is no application fee for a partial scholarship awarded by College staff during overseas marketing visits.

Any scholarship funds not allocated during overseas marketing visits will be awarded at the same time as the full scholarships.

Any students wanting to be considered in October/November are required to pay the A\$200 non-refundable fee as outlined in the conditions for applying for a full scholarship.

International Scholarship Application Form for 2011 Entry.

The Department of Education (DOE), Western Australia is offering a number of scholarships for international students studying either the Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) or the Western Australian Universities' Foundation Program (WAUFP) at Tuart College in Perth. These scholarships are of two types: full course fee exemption scholarships and partial scholarships to the value of A\$5,000.

Conditions

1. Students must have lodged an Application Form with the International Office Tuart College by **29 October 2010**.
2. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit and school recommendation as judged by a selection panel of College representatives. Once a scholarship is awarded, no other discounts (eg sibling discount) apply.
3. Scholarship students who withdraw after 4 weeks of commencement of the course forfeit any refund of fees or Bond.

Applications: You need to attach the following to your application.

- Recent academic results which equate to Year 11 in Western Australia. The following are examples only, and applicants from all countries are eligible.

Singapore, Brunei	:	Completed 'O' Levels or results of preliminary examinations
Malaysia	:	Forecast SPM or completed SPM; Senior Middle 2 results.
Indonesia	:	SMU 11 or SMU 111
Hong Kong	:	HKCEE
Kenya	:	KCSE or O Levels
Zambia	:	Zambia Certificate of Education

Include your two most recent school reports with any predicted or mock results. Please contact the College or your education consultant if you need additional clarification on the eligibility of your results.

- A letter of recommendation from your current or previous school principal, counsellor or form teacher.
- A bank draft of A\$200 payable to Tuart College for full scholarship applications.
- A standard Application Form for study at Tuart College.
